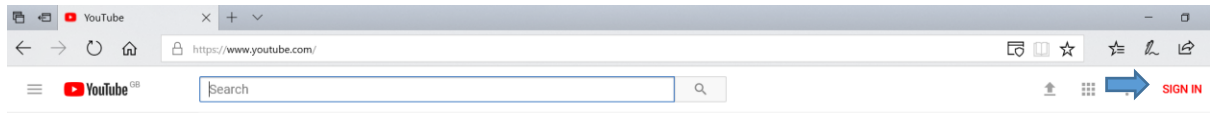
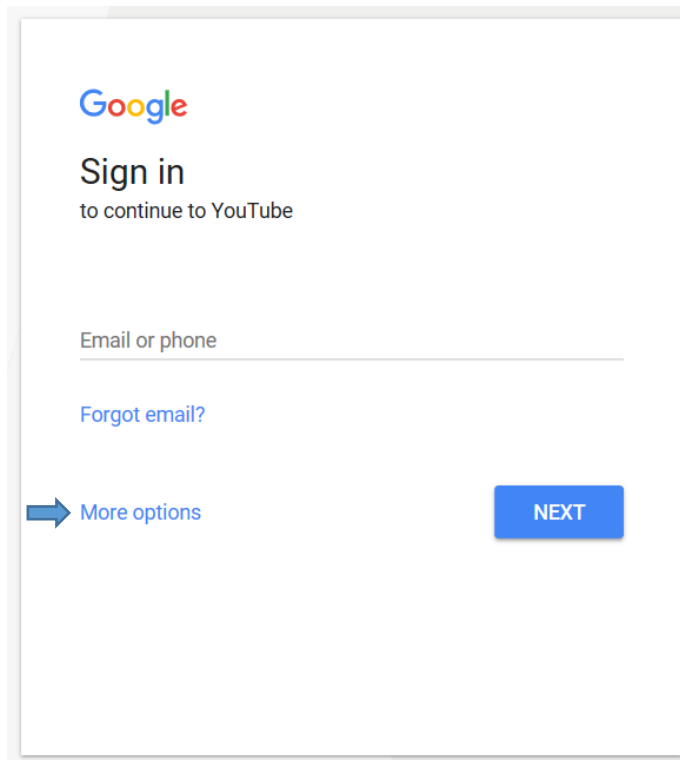


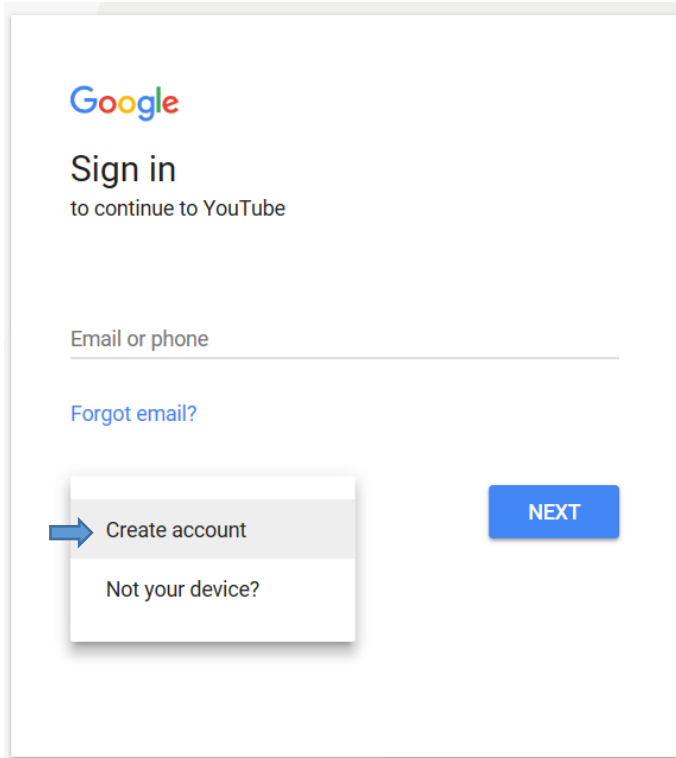
How to Create a YouTube Account and Upload a YouTube Video

- In the top right, click **Sign in**



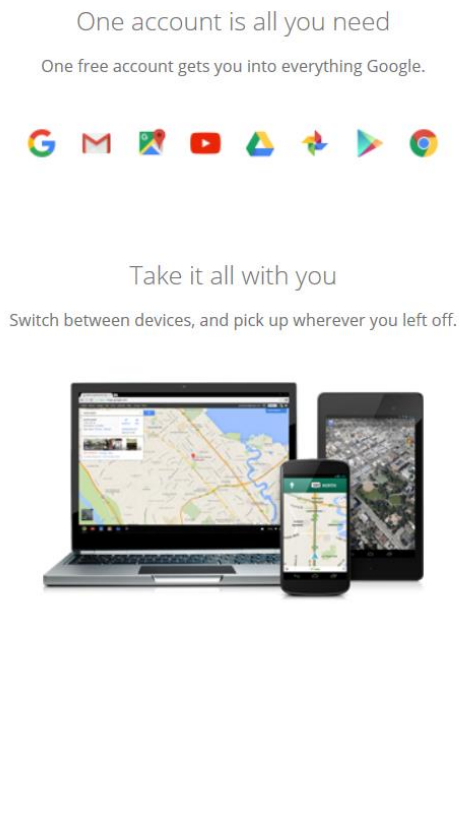
- Click on **More options > Create Account**

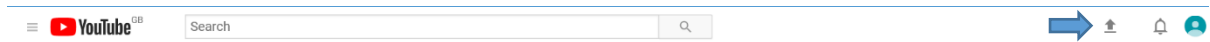

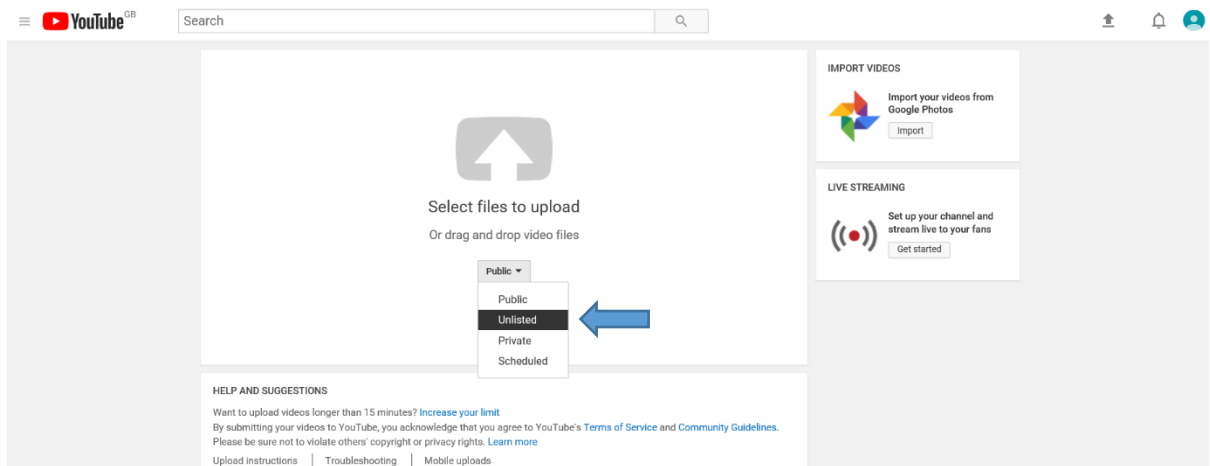

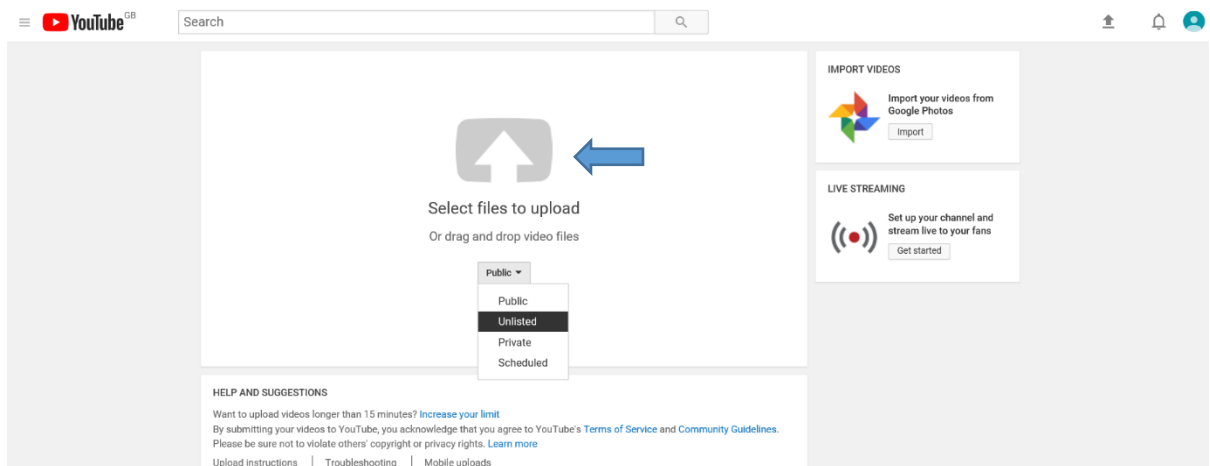
- Once you have registered your account and signed into YouTube using your chosen username and password, click on the upload icon on the top left of the screen:




- Click the drop down privacy settings menu and select “unlisted” before you begin uploading your video:



- Click on “Select Files to Upload” and select the relevant video file from your PC:




- Type the title of your video/performance piece in the relevant box:



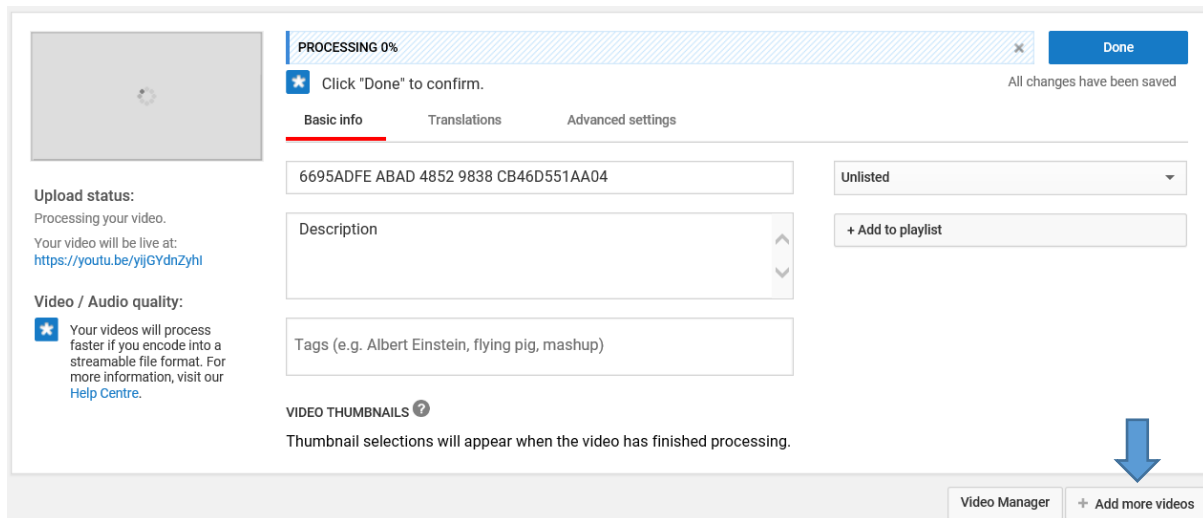
